a Situation of Gandhi's Life

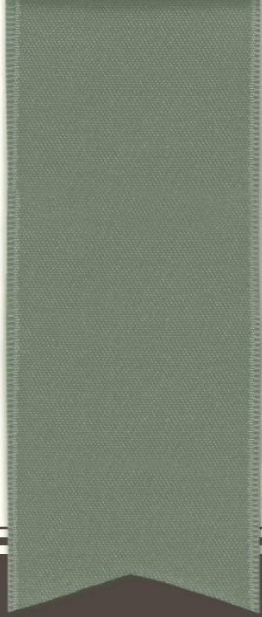

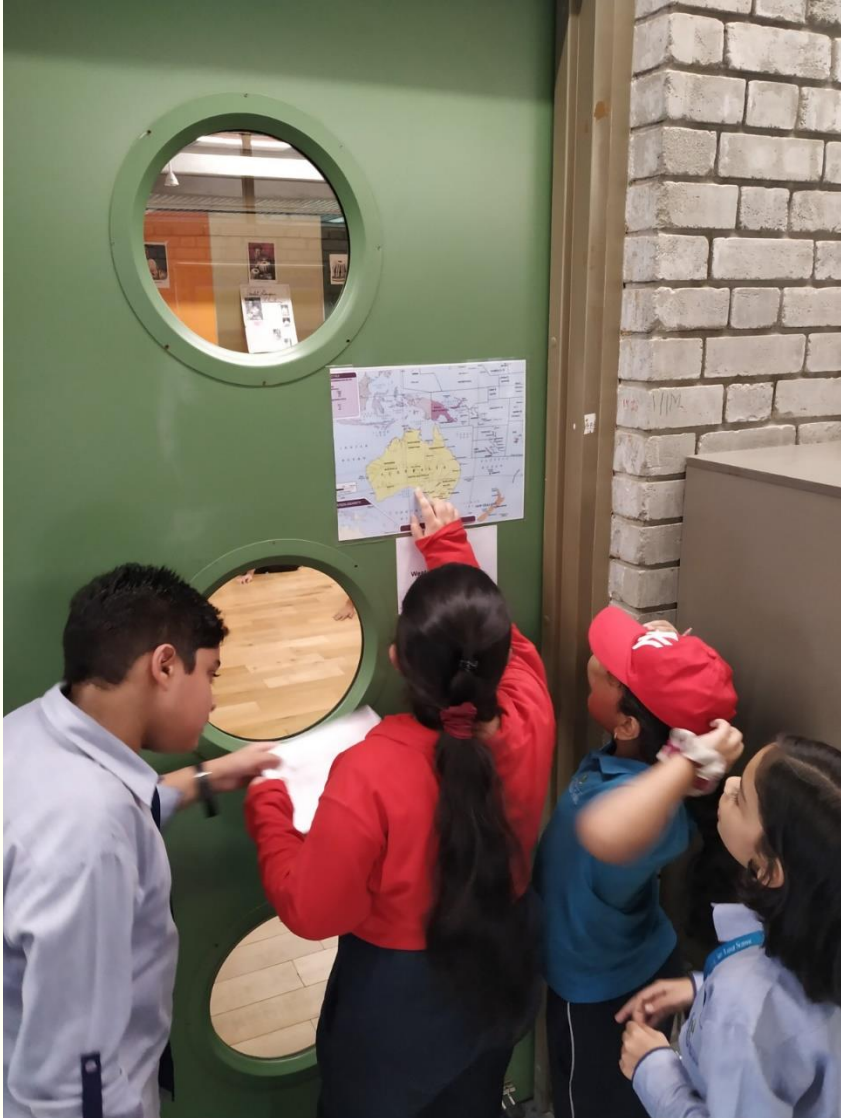

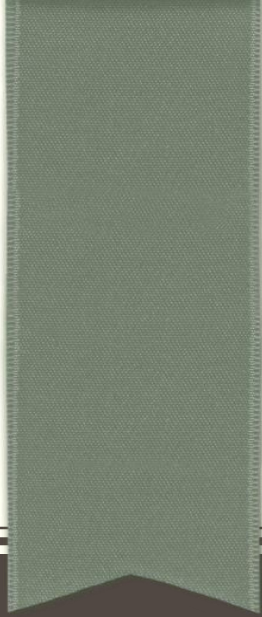
